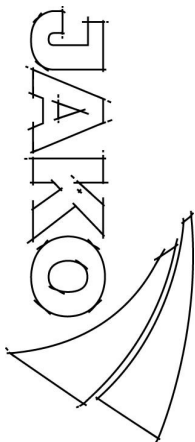

Tony Setzer is entering his 19th season at the helm of the Runnin' Bulldogs. During his tenure Setzer has produced several professional players, All-Americans, has won coach of the year honors, holds the career victory mark at GWU, and lead the Runnin' Bulldogs to a NSCAA Regional Ranking this past season, finishing 9-7-2. He holds a USSF "A" License. Setzer lead the Dogs to the NCAA College Cup 2nd Round in 2006, and was named ASUN Coach of the year.

Jason Osborne assistant men's coach at GWU, A native of the UK, Ozzy played for a pro-team, Derby County, as an apprentice until age 18 when he came to the US on a scholarship to Stetson University in Florida. He was selected all-conference all four years and was also an All-South Region Player. During the summer of 2005, he competed in the World Student games for England in Turkey, and was also selected for First team England Squad for Futsal. He has received six caps for England and 11 for Great Britain. Ozzy holds a UEFA B coaching license.
